**OUR WAY OF LIFE** Jesus advised us "Make your home in me as I make mine in you". The way to find myself is to insert myself into Jesus (already done by water if we are baptised); each day we are free to receive the greatest Gift of God, the Holy Spirit to form us into the One Body of Christ.

**A REFLECTION** By letting the Word of God in to us, we will bear much fruit which means to find inner peace and joy and help others to find the same.

**WORD OF LIFE** *By contrast, the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, generosity, faithfulness, gentleness, and self-control Galatians 5 :22.* St Paul was writing to the Christians in the region of Galatia, who had welcomed the Gospel when he had proclaimed it to them. Now he was admonishing them for not understanding the real meaning of Christian freedom. For the people of Israel, freedom was a gift from God who had brought them out of slavery in Egypt and led them to a new land, establishing a pact of mutual faithfulness with them. Now Paul strongly affirms that Christian freedom is a gift from Jesus. In fact, Jesus makes it possible for us, in him and like him, to become children of God who is Love. By imitating the Father as Jesus taught us<sup>1</sup> and showed us<sup>2</sup> through his life, we too can learn to have the same attitude of mercy towards everyone, and be at their service.
