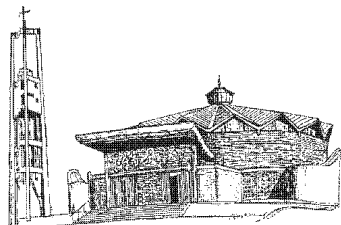

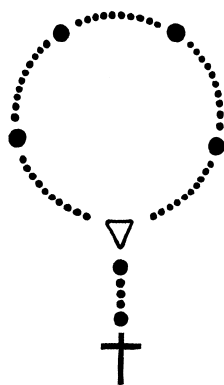

WORD OF LIFE

By standing firm you will win true life for yourselves (Luke 21:19)

'Standing firm'. The original Greek word from which these words are derived is rich in content: it means patience, constancy, resistance, trust. Standing firm is necessary and indispensable when we suffer, when tempted, when prone to discouragement, when enticed by the seductive pleasures of the world and when experiencing persecution. I expect that you too have found yourself in at least one of these situations and have experienced that, without standing firm, you would have succumbed. Perhaps you have sometimes given in. Maybe now, at this very moment, you find yourself immersed in one of these painful situations. So what should you do? Start again and . . . stand firm. Otherwise the name 'Christian' is not suitable for you.
