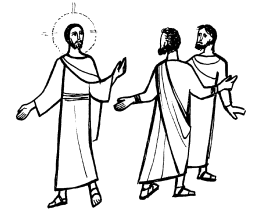

**WAY OF LIFE** Pope Francis' general audience, June 18th. 2014 The Prophet Hosea says, "I have walked with you and I taught you how to walk as a Father teaches his child to walk". It's beautiful - this image of God! And He is like that with us: He teaches us to walk. It is the same attitude He maintains towards the Church. We too, despite our resolve to follow the Lord Jesus, experience every day the selfishness and hardness of our heart. When, however, we recognise ourselves as sinners, God fills us with His mercy and with His love. Reflection: Where are you right now in your walk with God? Where is He trying to lead you? Where have you been selfish? We can start our walk again or walk more closely with the Lord when we admit that we are sinners in need of His help and Mercy. Renew your walk with Him.
