One year ago the Paris Conference on Climate Change took place. Pope Francis' letter LAUDATO SI is about us caring for our common home. The Pope connects the care of the natural world with justice for the poorest and most vulnerable. In Luke's gospel, Jesus warns the people about the signs for the end of the World, including wars, revolutions, earthquakes, plagues, famine and persecution of his disciples. Nobody should be afraid: not a hair of our heads will be lost; our endurance as believing disciples will win us our lives.

Reflection: / If fear dominates our lives are we in some way without a real relationship with Jesus who longs to set us free from being afraid? What can help us to find true peace and joy and the managing of our fears

WORD OF LIFE "I can do all things through him who strengthens me." (Phil 4:13)
Few people like Paul have experienced such intense joys and pain, successes and lack of understanding. And yet confronting all risks he managed to carry on with his mission, without giving in to discouragement. Was he a superhero? No, he felt himself weak, fragile, inadequate, but he had a secret, one he shared with his friends in Philippi: 'I can do all things through him who strengthens me.' In his own life he had discovered the constant presence of Jesus. Even when everyone had forsaken him, Paul did not feel alone. Jesus stayed close by. He it was who gave Paul security and urged him to go on, to face every hardship.
