**WAY OF LIFE** Pope Francis writes: Dear friends, we don't ever thank the Lord enough for the gift He has given us in the Eucharist! It is a very great gift, and that is why it is so important to go to Mass on Sunday. Go to Mass not just to pray, but to receive Communion, the bread that is the Body of Jesus Christ, who saves us, forgives us, unites us to the Father. It is a beautiful thing to do! We go to Mass every Sunday because that is the day of the Resurrection of the Lord. That is why Sunday is so important to us.
