On May 28<sup>th</sup> he bikes from Berlin reaching Arramanches (Normandy) June 5<sup>th</sup>, to raise money for the Royal British Legion. (950 miles!!) In preparation for my ride I discovered that 3 of my great uncles from Ireland died fighting for the Allies during the First World War, 2 of them at the Battle of the Somme.*

**WAY OF LIFE** Pope Francis writes at His general audience February 2014.

When participating in Holy Mass, we find ourselves with all sorts of different people: young people, the elderly, and children; poor and well-off; locals and strangers alike; people with their families and people who are alone.... But the Eucharist which I celebrate, does it lead me to truly feel they are all like brothers and sisters? Does it increase my capacity to rejoice with those who are rejoicing and cry with those who are crying? Does it urge me to go out to the poor, the sick, the marginalized? Does it help me to recognise in their faces the face of Christ? *Reflect on the Holy Father's questions above. The Eucharist is an intimate encounter with God's mercy. Does this encounter with God's mercy change you so that you are more attuned to the needs of others?*

**WORD OF LIFE** "He will dwell with them; they will be his peoples, and God himself will be with them (Rev 21:3) Let us hope that the Lord brings about a new order in the world. Only he can make humanity a family and cultivate the unique characteristics of each people so that the splendour of each, placed at the service of others, may shine with one light of life. This light of life in making beautiful each earthly country will make it the antechamber of the Eternal Country.
