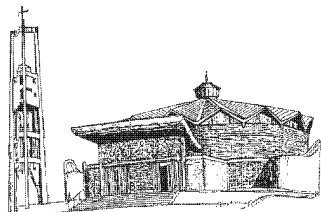

WORD OF LIFE

Those who find their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. (Mt 10:39)

On reading these words of Jesus, two kinds of life stand out: earthly life, which is built in this world, and supernatural life, which is given by God through Jesus and is a life that does not end with death and which no one can take from us. So, faced with our own existence, there are two attitudes we can have. One is to be attached to earthly life, considering it our only 'good'. This leads us to think only of ourselves, our own issues, the things of this world. We close ourselves in our shell, affirming only our ego, finding at the end of it all, inevitably, only death. Or, on other hand, believing that we have received a much deeper and truer existence from God, we can have the courage to live up to this gift, even to the point of knowing how to sacrifice our earthly life for the other life.
