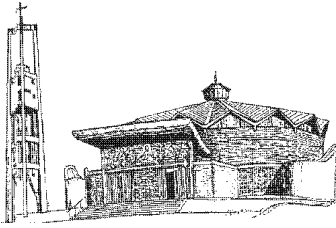

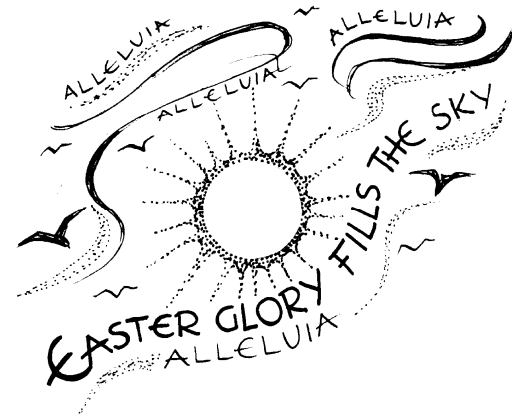

11.30 am - 12 noon. The list is in the Narthex and seems to be filling up fast. Mark you; it is a very good day out!!

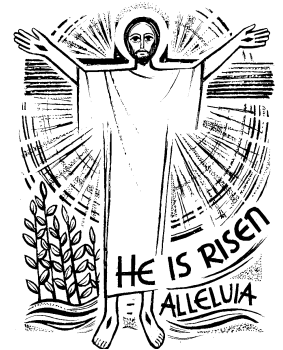

WORD OF LIFE

I am the resurrection and the life (Jn 11:25)

Jesus said these words after the death of Lazarus of Bethany, the Lazarus he raised to life four days after he'd died. Lazarus had two sisters, Martha and Mary. When

Martha heard that Jesus was coming, she immediately ran to meet him and said, "Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died." "Your brother will rise again," Jesus answered. She replied, "I know that he will rise again in the resurrection on the last day." Then Jesus declared: "I am the resurrection and the life. Those who believe in me, even though they die, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die."
