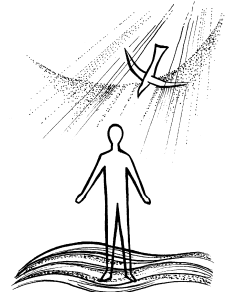

WORD OF LIFE
Christ, the Church's one foundation (cf 1 Cor 3:11).
In AD 50 Paul arrived in Corinth. It was a large Greek city, well known for its important commercial port and lively because of its many currents of thought. He spent eighteen months there proclaiming the Gospel and laid the basis for a flourishing Christian community. Others came after him and continued the work of evangelization. The new Christians they had evangelized, however, tended to become attached to whoever had brought Christ's message to them, rather than to Christ himself. Factions arose: 'I belong to Paul,' some would say. Others, referring to their own favourite apostle, would say, 'I belong to Apollos' or 'I belong to Peter. 'Faced with the divisions that rocked the community, Paul vigorously intervened. He emphasized that the Church, like a building, like a temple, may have many builders. But it has a sole foundation, the living stone: Jesus Christ.
