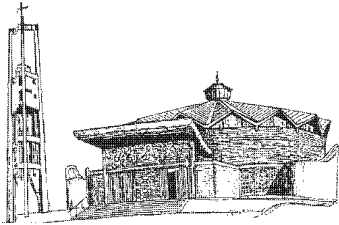

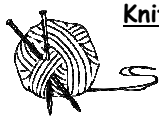

WORD OF LIFE

Give, and it will be given to you. A good measure, pressed down, shaken together, running over, will be put into your lap (Luke 6:38)

Remember that the gift must be given with no self-interest, with no hope of return, to anyone who asks. Try it. But not to see the result; try it because you love God. You might say, "I haven't got anything". That's not true. If we want, we possess inexhaustible treasures: our free time, our heart, our smile, our advice, our culture, our peace, our words that might persuade someone who has to give to someone who has not.
