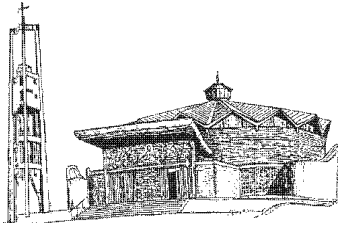


Regenerating the Parish



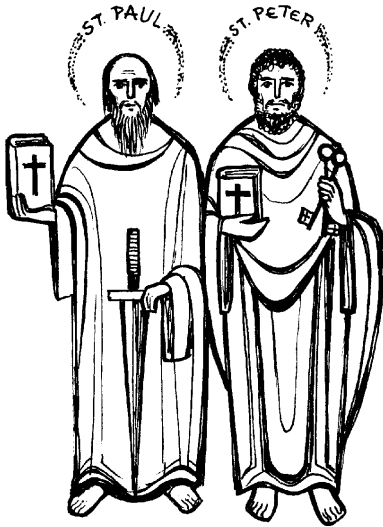
"He who listens to you listens to me" Jesus intends this saying for our relationship with those in authority in the Church, but what about to each other?

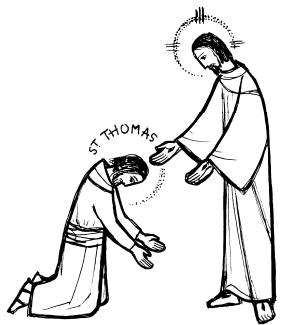

WORD O LIFE

I am the vine, you are the branches. Those who abide in me and I in them bear much fruit, because apart from me you can do nothing (John 15:5)

“Much fruit” does not only mean the spiritual and material wellbeing of others, but your own as well. Your inner growth, and your personal holiness as well, depend on your union with Christ. Holiness. Perhaps the word seems to you in the present age to be old fashioned, pointless, merely wishful thinking. But it isn't. The present age with its partial, false, limited vision will pass away. The truth will remain. Two thousand years ago, Paul the apostle said clearly that it was the will of God for all Christians to be sanctified. Teresa of Avila, a doctor of the Church, was certain that everyone, even someone just off the street, can reach the highest contemplation. And the Second Vatican Council declared that all the people of God are called to be saints. These are reliable voices. So see that in your life too you harvest the “much fruit” of holiness, which is possible only if you are united to Christ
