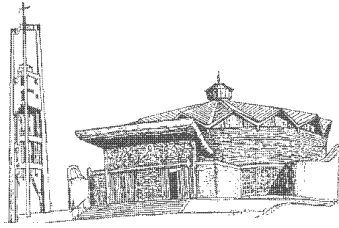

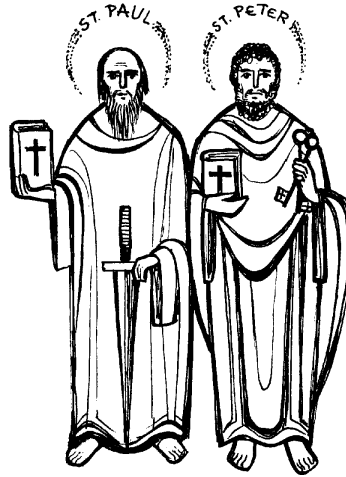

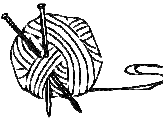

Readers for the Saturday Vigil Mass: As a result of illness and people moving, there are now just four of us on the rota. If you can help, please contact Mike on 01772 433430.

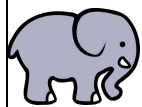

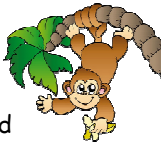
