Right To Life works very closely with the All Party Parliamentary Pro-Life Group and supports life in all its stages from conception to natural death. Right To Life is supported by people of all religions and none.

It is an 8 mile circular walk beginning in the car-park of the Church. The entrance to the car-park will be very visible with Right To Life posters and stewards at the entrance. Those wishing to take part are asked to be in the car park at 12.30 to enable Lord Alton to talk briefly on important pro-life issues. Archbishop Emeritus Patrick Kelly of Liverpool and Bishop John Arnold of Salford will also address the gathering. Parish Priest, Mgr. John Corcoran, will impart guidelines prior to the walk.

The walk is directed by parish helpers, and there are refreshments provided on the way. There is also a buffet laid on by the parishioners when the walk ends.

The terrain is uneven and muddy in parts, but Moira Billinge the organiser says she uses trainers or good walking shoes. Fast walkers do the route in 2 hours. The less strong *go at their own pace* and may take 2½ or 2¾ hours or more.
